Dear Friends and Neighbors,

I wanted to let you know that I have submitted legislation regarding 8-30g, CT affordable housing statute—a law that has directly impacted our community and continues to do so. My intention is to keep you apprised of all activity related to the 8-30g statute and affordable housing.

As the ranking house member of the legislature's Housing Committee, I have received a commitment from the co-chairs of the Housing committee that a public hearing on affordable housing and 8-30g will be held next month. Below are the details of the public hearing for Fairfield residents who wish to testify on the state affordable housing statutes.

I've had meetings with Mark Barnhart, Fairfield's Economic Development Director and, Stephen Grathwohl Chairman of Fairfield's Affordable Housing Commission, the Office of Legislative Research and the Fairfield delegation to discuss the challenges Fairfield is facing and the towns updated Affordable Housing long range plan.

I am hopeful we will be able to make positive changes to 8-30g this session and this public hearing is the first step.
